



Do not make 3-point turn along NJC Walk leading up to NJC (morning arrival).




Do not stop car along NJC (two-way traffic) and walk child to Gate 1.





- Do not drop your child at bus bay

THINGS TO NOTE FOR DISMISSAL






Dunearn Rd & Hillcrest Rd junction (Do not stop and wait along Dunearn Road & Hillcrest Road)

Hillcrest Rd (One-way: 1pm to 2pm, 3.30pm to 4.30pm)

NO PARKING / WAITING ALONG THESE ROADS



AFTERNOON DISMISSAL



- Gate 2 will be opened from 1.40pm to 2pm. After 2pm, please enter via Gate 1)
- Give way to pupils and pedestrians crossing at Gate 2 (Yellow Markings)
- Get your child to remember your car plate number
- Place a A4/A3 paper with your child's name and class written in BIG and BOLD letters for easy identification on your dashboard

GETTING OUT OF RGPS





Gate 3 (Exit to NJC Drive) Stop at White Line (Give Way to vehicles coming down from the right)

GETTING OUT OF RGPS



NJC Drive (No waiting or parking along this road)



NJC Drive & Dunearn Road Junction (Traffic light operating hours: 6.30am to 7.40am, 1.30pm to 2.30pm, 4.00pm to 4.30pm; Can proceed to turn if red light is not lit up and there is no oncoming traffic)

BE SAFE AND CONSIDERATE

- Drive slowly in and around school zones <u>15 km/h within school</u>
- Waiting/ Parking outside School
 - Please be considerate to the community
 - No indiscriminate waiting and parking along Hillcrest Road, Dunearn Road, Watten Rise, Watten Drive, Greenwood Avenue at all times
 - Avoid parking at zig-zag lines near zebra-crossing, within 6m of any junction and along roads with a centre solid white line
 - ITA and Traffic Police are stationed on site to monitor the traffic situation and carry out enforcement actions

DO's:

- Encourage your child to be independent (e.g. carry her own bag and alight on her own)
- Get your child ready to board/alight quickly (e.g sit on the correct side, place school bag in an accessible area)
- Arrive according to child's dismissal time to avoid waiting (e.g. come according to your oldest child's dismissal time)






RGPS CAR DECAL

GATE 2 OPENING HOURS




GATE 3 OPENING HOURS

PUPILS TAKING SCHOOL BUSES



- Pupils need to board the buses on time
- Buses will start to move off at 1.35pm

School Bus Behaviours

- During dismissal, always <u>walk</u> to your bus. Do not run/dash to the bus
- Do not play on the bus
- <u>Remain seated</u> and fasten your seat belt when the bus is moving
- Unfasten your seat belt only when the bus comes to a <u>complete stop</u>
- Do not eat on the bus. If you have to, please do not leave your litter in the bus.

WAITING FOR TH

Be there on time. Stand back, wait for the door to open.

RIDING THE BUS

Stay in your seat.

- Keep yourself and your things inside the windows.
- LISTEN to and OBEY your bus driver.

GETTING OFF THE BUS

Get off carefully, use the handrails.

- Stand where your bus driver can see you.
- Watch for the bus driver to signal you before crossing.
- Wait until the bus driver tells you it's OK to pick up anything you may have dropped.
